3. Full time students can take a maximum of twenty one (21) credits per semester
4. Part time students can take a maximum of eleven (11) credits per semester
5. Student in Year 1 are not allowed to select any Year 2 modules
6. Student are advised to do College Maths 1A before Calculus for Social Sciences
