

Important information REGULATION 3

•Grade Point Average (GPA?)

•.... GPA is a quantitative measure of a student's performance.....the average obtained by dividing the sum of the product of grade point and credit for each module by the total number of credits attempted. (Student handbook, pages 154-155)

Minimum GPA

- 2.0 for students admitted 2018/2019
- Shows students average grade for all modules throughout duration of study
- GPA is affected by all grades...whether pass or fail
 - Calculation of GPA Table 4, (Page 155)

Important information

- Components of GPA
- 1) Credits
 - The points a student gets for completing modules at levels 1, 2, 3, 4
 - Students are required to complete a certain number of <u>credits</u> for each level. Level 2 – 26-59, level 3 59-92 and level 4 – 92 and above
 - They are also required to have a certain number of credits to be awarded a degree

Important information

- Components of GPA
- 4) Grade points earned

The actual number of points students achieve when they take a module. This is based on:

- The number of credits for each module
- The letter grade received after completing a course
- The grade points allotted based on the letter grade received

Example: You get an A- (3.71) for a 3 credit course. You would have earned 11.13 grade points

Important information

- Academic Probation
- A student is placed on academic probation (AP) if their GPA is below 2.0
 - After two consecutive years on AP, the student is at risk of being discontinued from their course of study
 - A student with a discontinued status either has to leave UTECH or chose another course of study
 - Time lost
 - Money lost
