Frequently Asked Questions

Question: How do I select modules?

Answer: Visit the University's website (www.utech.edu.jm) and click on Students tab, then e:Vision portal to complete your module selection.

Question: How many credits can I select per semester?

Answer: Students are required to complete a minimum of **nine (9) credits** per semester and maximum of 21 credits per semester. Note: Modules are generally three (3) credits.

Question: What is a university elective?

Answer: A university elective is one of the several general education modules that a student is required to complete in order to qualify for the LLB.

Question: How many credits are required to complete the Bachelor of Laws programme?

Answer: Students are required to complete **one hundred (100) credits** as outlined on the module selection guide.

Question: Can I add/drop a module after registration?

Answer: Yes, you can use the online Add/Drop Request System or apply to Withdrawal from a Module. (Refer to the university calendar and student handbook).

Question: Can I complete a module and its prerequisite simultaneously?

Answer: No, students cannot complete a module and its prerequisite simultaneously.

Question: Can I apply for Transfer of Credits or Module Exemption?

Answer: Yes (please see Transfer of Credit policy in the Students Handbook).

Question: Will the Transfer of Credits or Module Exemption reduce the duration of the programme?

Answer: The Transfer of Credit or Module Exemption can reduce your workload but it does not necessarily reduce the duration of the programme.

Question: What is the maximum time permissible to complete the Bachelor of Laws programme?

Answer: Students are given a maximum of **six (6) years** to complete the Bachelor of Laws programme (**please see student handbook**).

Question: Can I take a break from my studies?

Answer: Yes, students may apply for a Leave of Absence or a Withdrawal from Course of Study by completing the FSAAC Form (*please see Student Handbook*).
