

Installation Guide: Microsoft Authenticator

A multi-factor authenticator is an app or device which produces a temporary token (verification code/push notification) used to confirm your identity when logging into Office 365.

Microsoft Authenticator is a free multi-factor authentication app that Microsoft encourages you to use for MFA since it will give you 'push' notifications that you simply accept to confirm and proceed.

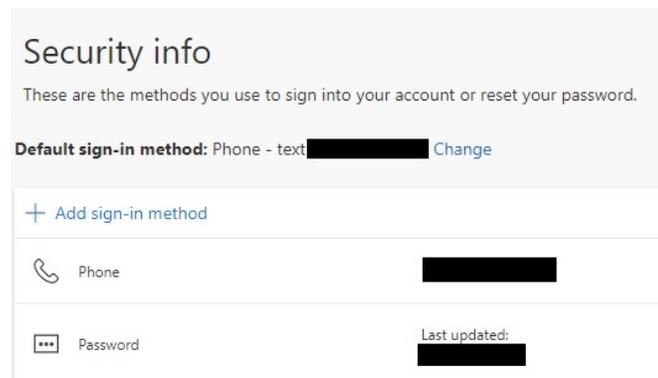
What you need:

- Access to the internet

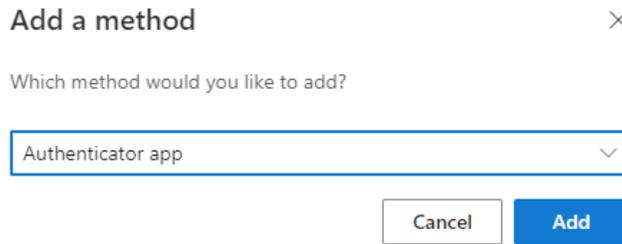
ADDING MICROSOFT AUTHENTICATOR APP TO YOUR ACCOUNT

Step 1: In your browser, go to 'My Sign ins' page at <https://mysignins.microsoft.com/security-info>

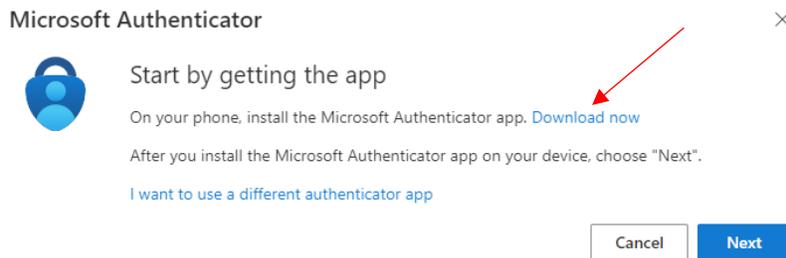
Step 2: Click on 'Add sign-in method'



Step 3: From the drop-down menu, select 'Authenticator App' the click 'Add'



Step 4: If you haven't downloaded the app yet, select 'Download now' to get the link for the app in your App store or Play Store.



If you already have Microsoft Authenticator downloaded, click on the 'Next' button to continue setup.

Step 5: Follow the on-screen instructions to download the app and complete setup.

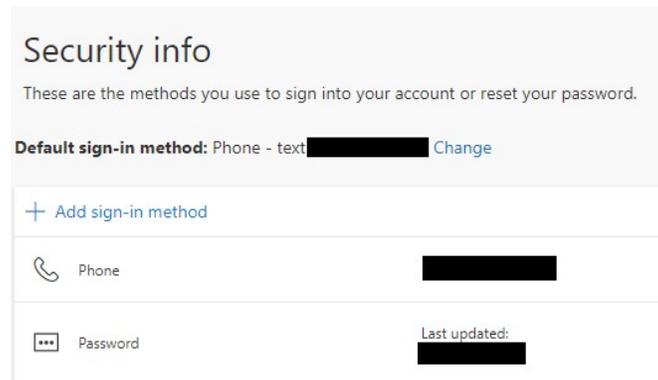

OTHER AUTHENTICATOR APPS

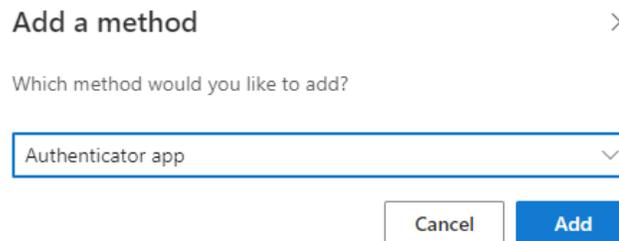
If you already have an authenticator app and wish to use this with your Office 365 account, you may do so.

Step 1: In your browser, go to 'My Sign ins' page at <https://mysignins.microsoft.com/security-info>

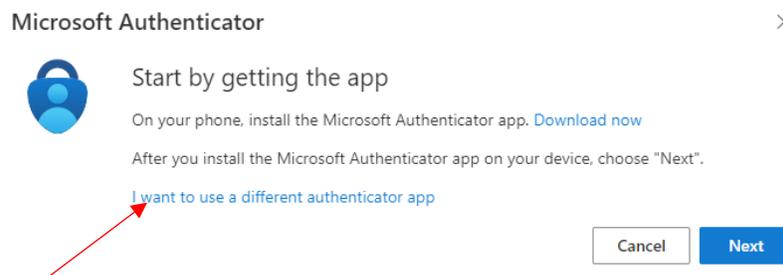
Step 2: Click on 'Add sign-in method'
